Dear Mr. Campbell:

This is in reference to the request filed November 16, 2012. YBC requests further extension of the STA granted on March 17, 2006, to operate Station KVNA with emergency antenna facilities pursuant to Section 73.1680. In support of the request, YBC states that it continues to finalize negotiations for a new site so that an FCC Form 301 application may be filed to change site.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KVNA may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates:

35° 13' 43" N, 111° 34' 05" W (NAD 1927)

Frequency:

600 kHz

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> KVNA is licensed for operation on 600 kHz with 1 kilowatt daytime and 0.048 kilowatt nighttime, employing a nondirectional antenna.

Hours of operation:

Unlimited

Operating power:

Not to exceed 1 kW daytime, 0.048 kW nighttime

Antenna

Long wire

It will be necessary to reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. YBC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.<sup>2</sup> YBC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on June 21, 2013.
