Dear Ms. Searcy:

Command Communications, Inc. ("Command"), licensee of KJQY(FM), San Diego, California, hereby requests that a new license to its auxiliary antenna (FCC File No. BLH-850424KS) be issued to specify the correct North Latitude. The current license erroneously specifies the North Latitude as 35° 50' 21''. See Attachment A. However the actual North Latitude of the antenna is 32° 50' 21''. Therefore, a new license should be issued to specify the North Latitude as 32°.

The Commission was initially notified of this error by the former licensee of KJQY(FM), in a letter dated April 24, 1985. See Attachment B. However, the Commission apparently never
