Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed May 7, 2009, on behalf of Valdosta State University ("VSU"). VSU requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted November 14, 2008 to operate Station WVVS-FM with temporary facilities.¹

On March 10, 2010, WVVS-FM was granted construction permit BPED-20100129ABP for permanent facilities. That construction permit expires March 10, 2013, by which time all construction is to be complete and a license application filed. Therefore, the STA should not be needed after that time. To facilitate the switch to the new facilities, the STA extension IS **HEREBY GRANTED** to expire March 25, 2013. Until March 25, 2013, station WVVS-FM may operate the following temporary facilities:

Geographic coordinates:	30° 50' 50" N, 83° 17' 36" W (NAD 1927)
Channel	215 (90.9 MHz)
Effective radiated power:	0.01 kilowatt (H&V)
Antenna type:	Nondirectional
Antenna height:	
above ground:	10 meters
above mean sea level:	68 meters
Above average terrain:	11 meters

¹ WVVS-FM is licensed for operation on Channel 215A (90.9 MHz) with effective radiated power of 5.3 kilowatts (H only) and antenna height above average terrain of 21 meters.

VSU must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **March 25, 2013**.
