Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Peltzman:

This letter concerns the request you filed on November 8, 2012, on behalf of Jose Antonio Aguilar ("Aguilar"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Radio Station KGDL to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that Aguilar stated that Station KGDL(FM) went silent on April 4, 2012, for staffing reasons. The previous STA was granted on May 14, 2012, and expired on November, 10, 2012. Aguilar requests extension of its STA because of continued staffing problems. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

Aguilar's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KGDL(FM) to remain silent until April 4, 2013. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KGDL(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., April 5, 2013. See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
