NOTIFICATION OF TEMPORARY REDUCTION IN OPERATING POWER

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of **Cayuga County Community College** ("Cayuga"), Licensee of **Radio Station WDWN-FM at Auburn, New York**, we hereby provide §73.1560 notification that as of November 29, 2012, WDWN-FM has been operating at reduced power ERP of 360 watts.¹ The station's transmitter is in need of repair, and Cayuga has been advised that such repairs might not be completed until about December 19, 2012.

Cayuga will advise the Commission when full power operations resume. However, in the event these reduced power operations need to continue past December 28, 2012, the requisite Request for Special Temporary Authority will be filed prior to that date.
