On behalf of KVOA Communications, Inc., licensee of K20FO, Sierra Vista, Arizona, this letter serves as notification pursuant to Section 73.1740(a)(4) of the FCC Rules that Station K20FO was temporarily off-the-air due to a wind storm damage to the antenna. Temporary repairs have been made to the antenna and the station is operating at half-power.
