The following application, seeking the facilities of former station KDOV, Medford, Oregon (not to be confused with the present station KDOV, Ashland, Oregon (1350 kHz, 1 kW, Day), has been accepted for filing. Public Notice of the acceptance of the application was released by the Commission on December 31, 1975. The Commission's decision denying the renewal of the license of KDOV, Medford, Oregon, was affirmed by the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit on February 3, 1975. The Commission will also accept any other applications for consolidation with this application which propose essentially the same facilities. Since there are presently six aural broadcast stations presently operating in Medford, interim proposals to operate on 1300 kHz are not being invited.
