My name is Kenneth J. (Ken) Brown, a consultant to Radio Disney Group, licensee of KMIC Houston. After conversation with Susan Crawford, and having done these notifications this way for years with Norm Miller, I write to advise you that KMIC is done with BSTA-20120814ABJ and is operating normally. Several deteriorated ground clips were replaced and, while in there, certain contactors no longer in prime shape were also replaced. These actions restored operation to normal, and after watching it for several weeks, it appears clear that all is well and stable. Thank you for your assistance.

Given that I don't see a form in the CDBS informal area quite appropriate for this purpose, and that getting a letter through lawyers always takes time and complexities, if you have no objections, we will continue to notify "done with STA" in this manner.
