Dear Mr. Langham:

This is in reference to the request filed November 19, 2012. Capstar requests extension of the STA granted on May 30, 2012, to operate Station WBIZ with emergency antenna facilities pursuant to Section 73.1680.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, Capstar has now indicated a license application has been filed to cover the permit to replace the station's collapsed tower.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WBIZ may continue to operate from its licensed site with an emergency wire antenna and reduced power not to



<sup>1</sup> WBIZ is licensed for operation on 1400 kHz with 1 kilowatt daytime and 1 kilowatt nighttime, employing a nondirectional antenna (ND-2-U).

exceed 1 kilowatt. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Capstar must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.<sup>2</sup> Capstar must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **September 12, 2013**.
