Request for Extension of Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Trent:

This letter concerns the request you filed on February 25, 2013, on behalf of Gulf Coast Broadcasting Co., Inc. ("GCB"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit AM Radio Station WDXZ to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that GCB stated that Station WDXZ(AM) went silent on August 16, 2012, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on October 4, 2012, and will expire on April 2, 2013. GCB requests extension of its STA for technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

GCB's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WDXZ(AM) to remain silent until August 16, 2013. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WDXZ(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., August 17, 2013.**¹ See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
