
Calvary Chapel of the Niagara Frontier ("CCNF") and Medaille College ("Medaille") are the remaining two of nine applicants that filed mutually exclusive applications for a new noncommercial educational station on Channel 221A at Amherst, New York. By letter dated February 1, 2013, the above-captioned applicants requested additional time, until March 6, 2013, to reach a voluntary time-sharing agreement that would resolve their proceeding without the need for a hearing.

CCNF and Medaille have continued to engage in good faith settlement discussions and believe that it may be possible to reach a settlement within the next sixty (60) days, i.e., by May 3, 2013. Accordingly, the applicants respectfully request that the Commission not designate their respective applications on the issue of an appropriate time-sharing arrangement prior to May 3, 2013, so that the applicants may continue to negotiate with a view to reaching a mutually acceptable voluntary time-share arrangement. Counsel for Medaille has indicated Medaille's consent to the filing of this request.
