This refers to your attorney's letter dated April 5, 2013 requesting special temporary authority to remain silent. You mentioned that because the power supplied to the transmitter was not available due to the result of a dispute with the local power company, WOST went off the air on February 25, 2013.

In light of the above, special temporary authority to remain dark pursuant to Sections 73.1740 of the Commission's Rules until October 9, 2013 IS GRANTED.

During this period of discontinued operation, you are directed to pay strict attention to Section 73.1740 (a) (4). That is, you must continue to adhere to the requirements in your station license pertaining to the lighting of antenna structures.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
