Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to the letter dated March 12, 2013, from the Video Division to the above-named Licensee, regarding K20JX-D's apparent failure to comply with the Station's online public file requirements. A copy of the letter can be viewed in the station's correspondence folder in the Commission's Broadcast Radio & Television Electronic Filing System (CDBS).

Commission records indicate that Abundant Life Broadcasting failed to upload to the Commission's website its main studio address, and/or the required issues/programs lists and/or the required documentation sufficient to demonstrate that the Class A station is continuing to meet its Class A eligibility requirements. The letter required that these deficiencies be addressed within 10 days and stated that failure to provide the requested information or to notify the staff that you were electing to let the Station revert to low power television status would result in the institution of a forfeiture proceeding and/or loss of Class A television status.

As of today, the Commission has not received a response to the letter. Failure to provide the information required in the letter within 30 days from the date of this letter will result in a change of the station's status from Class A television to low power television status.
