Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change application, as amended on April 11, 2013, to modify effective radiated power, transmitter location, and antenna height.

A study of the application reveals that the proposal is short-spaced by 4 kilometers to the first-adjacent channel reserved assignment at Montecito, California. The required spacing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.207 is 96 kilometers while the actual spacing proposed in the application is 92 kilometers. This short spacing was not recognized in the application. Therefore, the applicant must amend all pertinent parts of the application in order to eliminate this short spacing.

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3522(a)(6), "... an applicant whose application is found to meet the minimum filing requirements but nevertheless is not complete and acceptable shall have the opportunity in the 30-day period specified in the FCC staff's deficiency letter to correct all deficiencies in the tenderability and acceptability of the underlying application, including any deficiency not specifically identified by the staff." Additionally, 47 C.F.R. § 73.3564(a) states that, "[a]pplications with uncorrected tender and/or acceptance defects remaining after the opportunity for corrective amendment will be dismissed with no further opportunity for corrective amendment." See Appendix B in the Report and Order in MM Docket No. 91-347, 7 FCC Rcd. 5074, 57 Fed. Reg. 34872, released July 27, 1992. This letter constitutes KLSI's opportunity for corrective amendment pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3522(a)(6).

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty days from the date of this letter to provide KLSI an opportunity to respond. Failure to correct all tender and acceptance defects within thirty days from the date of this letter will result in dismissal of the application with no further opportunity for corrective amendment pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3564(a). Please note that any amendment must be submitted in the same manner as the original application.
