Resumption of Full-Power Operations**


Dear Ms. Dortch:

CCR-Lamar IV, LLC, the licensee of KLMR-FM, by its counsel, hereby notifies the Commission that the station has resumed full-power operations.

KLMR-FM began operating with reduced power on February 22 following damage to the station's antenna and transmission line. CCR-Lamar requested and received special temporary authority for the station to operate with reduced power using a temporary broadband antenna while the necessary repairs were completed (see BSTA-20130301AGB). Repairs have been completed, and the station has now resumed full-power operations with an eight-bay ERI center fed antenna (SHP-8AC). CCR-Lamar has filed a license modification application (BMLH-20130425AAI) to obtain authorization for use of the new antenna. The station is now operating pursuant to program test authority with the new antenna, as opposed to the STA.
