Re: Zimmer Radio, Inc. (ZRI) KZYM (AM), Joplin, Missouri Facility Identification Number: 407 Special Temporary Authority (STA) BESTA-20130510ACY

Dear Mr. Jazzo:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 10, 2013. ZRI requests an extension of the STA originally granted on November 13, 2012, to operate Station KZYM with emergency antenna facilities pursuant to Section 73.1680.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, ZRI states continued STA operation is needed to allow time to complete all repairs and file an FCC Form 301 application to modify the licensed facility.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KZYM may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Frequency:	1230 kHz
Operating hours:	Unlimited
Operating power:	Not to exceed 0.55 kW
Antenna:	Existing tower - series fed
Radiator height:	181.4° (122.8 meters)

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. ZRI must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.<sup>2</sup> ZRI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on December 7, 2013.
