



Fatima Family Apostolate International, Inc. (FFAI) is a non-stock, non-profit corporation chartered in the State of Alabama with tax-exempt status granted by the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to 26 U.S.C. §501(c)(3). FFAI hereby certifies that it intends to operate station WQHC(AM) in accordance with Section 73.503 of the FCC's Rules.

Educational Mission of FFAI

FFAI was formed to, *inter alia*, engage in educational activities. As noted above, it has been granted tax exempt status pursuant to 26 U.S.C §501(c)(3) by the Internal Revenue Service.

FFAI's educational mission involves the teaching of Roman Catholic doctrine generally, with particular emphasis on educating the public as to the role of the Christian family in the modern world as stated by the late Pope John Paul II in his November 22, 1981 apostolic exhortation *Familiaris Consortio*. Additionally, FFAI would educate the public about the famous religious events that took place in Fatima, Portugal in 1917.

Located in Hanceville, Alabama, FFAI intends to work with the nearby Our Lady of the Angels Monastery, as well as with Catholic parishes in the Hanceville-Cullman area, in educating the public.

Programming In Furtherance of FFAI's Educational Mission

Most of the programming to be aired by FFAI over WQHC(AM) will come from the radio service of Eternal Word Television Network (EWTN). EWTN is headquartered on the former site of Our Lady of the Angels Monastery in Irondale, Alabama, which was founded and operated by the Roman Catholic order of nuns known as Poor Clares of Perpetual Adoration. The founder of Our Lady of the Angels is Mother M. Angelica, P.C.P.A. The main purpose of EWTN has been described by Mother Angelica as "catechesis": that is, the teaching of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the Catechism of the Roman Catholic Church.

EWTN's programming is commercial-free, and there is no paid programming which is aired on EWTN. Such programming would be broadcast over WQHC(AM) in a commercial-free manner. Programming consists of the following basic types: (1) rebroadcasts of "Interactive" programs which involve a host or moderator and call-in questions from listeners; (2) recorded programs presented by eminent Roman Catholic professors and scholars dealing with various topics of the Gospels and Roman Catholic catechism (categories 1 and 2 occupy a majority of the broadcast day); (3) Roman Catholic Masses, the Holy Rosary and various recitations of various devotionals; and (4) news programs known by the title "Catholic World Today" and "The World Over".

The current EWTN radio programming schedule, much of which we expect to implement at WQHC(AM) (although this is subject to change at the time FFAI acquires WQHC(AM)), is appended hereto. FFAI intends to

supplement this network programming with programming produced by it relative to *Familiaris Consortio* and to Fatima.

Thus, the programming to be presented over WQHC(AM) presents a comprehensive daily effort to educate the public, Catholics and non-Catholics, about the tenets and dogmas of the Roman Catholic faith, including the Bible and the systematic Catechism of the Roman Catholic Church. As noted above, FFAI intends to work with local Roman Catholic organizations to assist their educational efforts with respect to teaching of the Catholic religion. In short, FFAI intends to develop WQHC(AM) as a valuable educational resource which will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be FATIMA FAMILY APOSTOLATE INTERNATIONAL, INC., a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Corporation is as follows:

(a) To promote and serve as a guide, inspiration and give directives for the international aspects of the Fatima Family Apostolate and all local, individual organizations using the name "Fatima Family Apostolate" wherever such organizations may exist in the world, to implement the goals of the document, Familiaris Consortio, (The Rold of the Christian Family in the Modern World) as outlined in the charter of the Fatima Family Apostolate and subsequently approved by the Pontificium Consilium Pro Familia (Pontifical Council for the Family) of the Vatican city state, and;

(b) To do all things necessary and incident to promote the general social, benevolent and charitable works of the corporation.

ARTICLE III: POWERS

(1) The corporation shall have all the general powers enumerated in the Code of Alabama, 1975, §10-3A-1 et seq.

(2) To receive and administer funds for the aforesaid purposes, and for no other purpose, and to that end to take and hold by contract, agreement, bequest, devise, gift, purchase, lease, either absolutely or in trust for such objects and purposes or trust and by membership fees received and contracts entered into for its purposes as herein stated and for no other purposes.

ARTICLE IV: INCORPORATORS

ARTICLE V: DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

The Board of Directors shall be composed of the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer. The Board of Directors shall have general administrative duties for the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI: AMENDMENT

These Articles may be amended by majority vote of the Board of Directors at any special or regular meeting.

ARTICLE VII: MEETINGS

The corporation shall have an annual meeting at a date and time as designated by the Board of Directors upon ten (10) days notice.

A special meeting may be called by the Board of Directors by giving ten (10) days notice. Notice may be accomplished by mail, e-mail, or telephone. The purpose of the special meeting shall be specified in the petition and the notice.

ARTICLE VIII: BY-LAWS

The Directors shall draft by-laws for the governance of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IX: REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The location and address of the corporation initial registered office is 865 Teem Road, Cullman, AL 35057.

ARTICLE X: AUTHORITY

Said corporation is organized on a non-stock basis. Said corporation is to be financed under the following general plan: by contributions to it of funds and property absolutely or in any of them, any property real, personal or mixed, without limitations as to amount or value, except such limitation, if any, as may be imposed by law; to sell, convey, and dispose of any such property and to deal with such property for any of the aforementioned purposes without limitation, except such limitations, if any, may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received; and to exercise any, all, and every power for which a nonprofit corporation organized under the provisions of the Alabama Nonprofit Corporation Act, all for the public welfare can be authorized to exercise, but not any other power.

ARTICLE XI: 501 (c) (3) STATUS

This nonprofit corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the

organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause above. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the internal revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code..

ARTICLE XII: DISSOLUTION


Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to any state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the court of common pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

All the property of this corporation and accumulations thereof shall be held and administered to effectuate its purposes and to serve the general welfare of the people of the State

of Alabama. Upon the dissolution of this nonprofit corporation for any cause, the assets of the corporation of whatever kind and wherever situated shall be distributed to any nonprofit corporation or governmental agency qualified to receive such distributions under §501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, to be used for the purposes set forth in Article Two hereinabove. No distribution of the assets of this corporation shall ever be made to any member, director or officer of this Corporation.
