Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Ms. Crump:

This letter concerns the request you filed on April 19, 2013, on behalf of North Texas Radio Group, LP ("NTRG"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Radio Station KETE(FM) to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that NTRG stated that Station KETE(FM) went silent on August 29, 2012, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on October 18, 2012, and expired on April 16, 2013. NTRG requests extension of its STA due to continued technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

NTRG's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KETE(FM) to remain silent until August 29, 2013. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KETE(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., August 30, 2013. See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
