RE: Notice of Return to Operation: Station KPKL-FM, Spokane, Washington

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 21, 2012, Spokane Broadcasting Company, the licensee of Station KPKL-FM, Spokane, Washington [Facility No. 3922], notified the Commission that it had been forced to reduce power due to a failed transmitter, and requested authorization to use the facilities of its booster station, KPKL-FM1. It notified the Commission on May 14, 2013 that as of January 18, 2013, Station KPKL(FM) resumed operation at 5 Kw of power pursuant to the STA granted on January 17, 2013 (BSTA-20121121ARR).

Please be advised that as of July 16, 2013, the station is now operating at its fully licensed parameters.

This resumption of KPKL's operation should be the final step in processing and granting the pending KPKL-FM1 booster license application (see BLFTB-20121105AKF). Accordingly, it is respectfully requested that this application be processed and granted.
