Dear Mr. Lipp:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 2, 2013. CBC requests further extension of the STA granted on January 25, 2011, to operate with an emergency nondirectional antenna and reduced power.¹ In support of the request, CBC states that repair work has been delayed by tornados, but will be completed so that an FCC Form 302-AM license application with a partial proof can be filed with the Commission to resume licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


We noted that the extension requested use of the previously authorized emergency antenna, nighttime tower #2(SW), but also requested the use of the much taller licensed daytime non-directional antenna at a different power level. Since CBC filed this as an extension request as of the authorized emergency antenna, and only one type of antenna system can be utilized for STA operations, it will be authorized to specify use of only the shorter emergency antenna.

¹ WKY is licensed for operation on 930 kHz with a 5 kw ND antenna day and a 5 kW DA antenna at night.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WKY may continue to operate with an emergency non-directional antenna using the 94.6° night tower #2(SW), and reduced power not to exceed 5 kW daytime and 1.25 kW nighttime, as necessary to facilitate all repairs. Operation also is authorized during nighttime hours with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. CBC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² CBC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 31, 2014**. If CBC would like to modify the original STA request in any way, such as requesting the use only the taller tower with a different power level, then a request for a new STA (not extension) should be filed before the expiration date shown above.
