This is in reference to the request filed July 8, 2013 on behalf of Delmarva Broadcasting Company ("DBC"). DBC requests further extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on January 8, 2013, to operate Station WDEL with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits.¹ In support of the request, DBC states that as previously reported, construction of the tower that is part of the WDEL(AM) array and which supports the WSTW(FM) antenna was completed. The licensee is in the process of replacing guy wires on WDEL towers #1 and #2. Thereafter, the licensee will conduct a partial proof of performance.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

¹ WDEL is licensed for operation on 1150 kHz with 5 kilowatts daytime and 5 kilowatts nighttime, employing different directional antenna patterns during daytime and nighttime hours. (DA-2-U). Construction Permit BP-20111012ABT authorizes an increase in the daytime power to 10 kilowatts and changes to the daytime pattern.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WDEL may continue to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. DBC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² DBC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on January 8, 2014.
