Dear Ms. Dortch:


On behalf of Norwell Television, LLC, licensee of Television Station WWDP, Norwell, Massachusetts, this will inform the Commission that, on August 7, 2013, a mistake by a contract electrician resulted in the station going off the air briefly and losing all master control functions.

Station personnel were able to resume broadcasting national programming within hours, and the station's tower lighting was unaffected by the disruption. The ability to insert local programming, including station ID, EAS alerts, children's programming, and public affairs programming, was interrupted. Since then, interim repairs have enabled the station to resume broadcasting children's and public affairs programming as scheduled, but the station continues to be unable to broadcast Station IDs and EAS alerts.

Repair work is continuing. Norwell Television, LLC will inform the Commission when full functionality has been restored.
