Re: Notification of resumption of operation of Station DWHYC(FM),
Facility ID 28177, Swan Quarter, North Carolina

Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am writing on behalf of the Hyde County Board of Education (“Board”), licensee of noncommercial educational FM Station DWHYC(FM), Swan Quarter, North Carolina, to advise the Commission that, according to Vanessa Bryant, the station’s manager, the station returned to operation on January 20, 2011.

This notification is being submitted on paper, rather than through CDBS, because of unanticipated complications apparently arising from the station’s current licensed status. The station’s license was cancelled in February, 2010, but the Board submitted a timely petition for reconsideration of that action in March. Pursuant to special temporary authority (File No. BLSTA-20100312AAF), the station has been operating since April pending action on the Board’s petition for reconsideration. However, in late December the station encountered technical problems and went off the air. Notice of that circumstance was submitted through CDBS on January 4, 2011. While the equipment that failed is still being repaired, the station was able to obtain a “loaner” which enabled it to return to the air within 30 days, Ms. Bryant advises.



However, apparently because CDBS reflects the station's license status as "License Cancelled", CDBS would not permit the online submission of a notice that the station has resumed operation.

When a similar circumstance occurred several months ago, it was determined that the appropriate course would be to submit a letter, on paper, describing this situation so that the Commission would have a complete record. This letter is being submitted pursuant to that approach.
