Request for Extension of Special Temporary  
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. O'Neil:

This letter concerns the request you filed on July 8, 2013, on behalf of Radio Power Inc. ("RR"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station W276BH to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that RR stated that Station W276BH went silent on October 19, 2012, for financial reasons. The previous STA was granted on January 3, 2013, and expired on July 2, 2013. RR requests extension of its STA for continued financial problems. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

RR's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station W276BH to remain silent until October 19, 2013. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station W276BH will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., July 9, 2014.**<sup>1</sup> See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
