This is in reference to your letter dated November 18, 2004, filed on behalf of Great Southern Broadcasting Company, Inc. ("GSB"), requesting further extension of the Special Temporary Authority (STA) originally granted on August 14, 1990', and modified on February 12, 1998', to duplicate the programming of Station WAMB on an FM channel for the purpose of restoring service lost due to interference from a co-channel Cuban station operating in excess of its notified power.

In support of the request, GSB states that the situation remains unchanged.

Accordingly, in light of the above, the request for extension of Special Temporary Authority IS HEREBY GRANTED. GSB may continue to operate Station WAMB-FM1 for the purpose of duplicating the programming of Station WAMB, nighttime hours only, with the following facilities:


