
Bott acquired the station on January 11, 2006 under BAL-20050818AAQ, granted October 6, 2005.

Dear Mr. Berry:

This is in reference to your letter dated November 18, 2004, filed on behalf of Great Southern Broadcasting Company, Inc. ("GSB"), requesting further extension of the Special Temporary Authority (STA) originally granted on August 14, 1990¹, and modified on February 12, 1998², to duplicate the programming of Station WAMB on an FM channel for the purpose of restoring service lost due to interference from a co-channel Cuban station operating in excess of its notified power.

In support of the request, GSB states that the situation remains unchanged.

Accordingly, in light of the above, the request for extension of Special Temporary Authority IS **HEREBY GRANTED**. GSB may continue to operate Station WAMB-FM1 for the purpose of duplicating the programming of Station WAMB, nighttime hours only, with the following facilities:

Transmitter site:	Tower #1 of licensed WAMB array
Geographic coordinates (NAD 1927):	36° 09' 41" N, 86° 42' 56" W (same as WAMB)
Channel:	254 (98.7 MHz)
Effective radiated power:	0.075 kilowatt (Max-DA, H&V)
Antenna height	
Above ground:	110 meters (360')
Above mean sea level:	241 meters
Above average terrain:	83 meters

² The original STA operation was on Channel 294, modified to Channel 254 on February 12, 1998.

GSB must take whatever action is necessary to prevent exposure of workers or the public to radio frequency fields in excess of the Commission's exposure limits. See 47 CFR Section 1.1307.

This authority expires on August 28, 2005.

This letter is a request by Great Southern Broadcasting Company, Inc., to extend the Special Temporary Authority (STA) for FM Booster Station WAMB-FM1, Donelson, Tennessee.

This request extends an STA first granted by the Commission on August 14, 1990, and modified and extended on February 12, 1998, to permit Great Southern Broadcasting Company, Inc., to duplicate the programming of Standard Station WAMB, Donelson, Tennessee, on an FM channel to alleviate serious nighttime interference to WAMB's signal caused by a co-channel Cuban broadcasting station.

Because this situation remains unchanged, Great Southern Broadcasting Company, Inc., seeks authority to maintain its present operation of WAMB-FM1 on Channel 254 so that it might continue to serve its nighttime audience without interference.


