
This letter is in reference to the above-captioned application filed by Potomac to modify the licensed Class D station WCRW(AM) by adding a 1 kW nighttime site facility.

A preliminary review of the application reveals that:

1. Potomac mentioned an environmental report (by Blueskies Environmental Associates, Inc.) to justify the acceptability of this application, therefore that report must be submitted in an electronic amendment as part of this application so that it can be reviewed by our staff.
2. We noted that Exhibit 13-Statement A indicated that the two existing towers at the proposed site were previously notified to the FAA, but that the TOWAIR program was used to show those two existing towers (along with additional two proposed towers) do not require FAA notification or registration now. Towers already notified to the FAA must be registered pursuant to Commission rules, regardless if any marking and lighting is required. As a result, Potomac must register the two existing towers with the FCC's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (<http://wireless.fcc.gov/antenna>).

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to file an amendment. Failure to amend within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the Commission's rules.
