This letter is a request by Great Southern Broadcasting Company, Inc. to extend the Special Temporary Authority for FM Booster Station WAMB-FMl, Donelson, Tennessee.

This request extends an STA first granted on August 14, 1990, to permit Great Southern Broadcasting Company, Inc. to duplicate the programming of standard station WAMB, Donelson, Tennessee, on an FM channel to alleviate serious nighttime interference to WAMB's signal caused by a co-channel Cuban broadcast station.
