Dear Ms. Williams,

This letter is to notify the FCC that FM Station WZLY 91.5 FM (Facility ID 71451) licensed to Wellesley College in Wellesley, Massachusetts, is temporarily ceasing broadcast operations, aka "going silent", as of September 3, 2013.

The College is conducting extensive renovations to the radio station's studio space and the station is going silent while the studios are relocated to a different location on-campus. The existing remote control system does not allow for operation from this location, so until a compatible remote control system can be installed that will allow proper monitoring and control of the transmitter, the station is electing to temporarily cease broadcasting.

An exact date for returning to normal broadcast operations is unknown at this time. Wellesley College is aware that if the silent period will exceed 30 days, then an application for Special Temporary Authority to remain silent must be filed.
