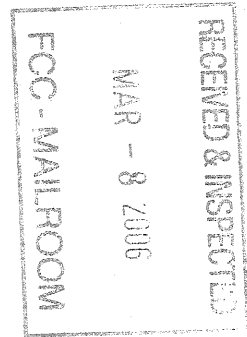


We have before us the captioned license for FM Translator station K244BX, Monroe, Louisiana.

The license for K244BX expired on August 1, 1990; hence, a renewal application was due on June 1, 1990, four months prior to the expiration of the license term.¹ J&J did not file a renewal application for this station in 1990, nor did it file the license renewal applications for K244BX were due in 1997 and 2004. J&J's failure to file the requisite license renewal applications results in the expiration of the K244BX license.

Accordingly, all authority to operate station K244BX, Monroe, Louisiana, IS **TERMINATED** and the call letters ARE **DELETED**. Any operation of this facility is now unauthorized and must cease immediately.

Finally, it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower be maintained until the tower is dismantled. Accordingly, the owner of the tower where the referenced station's transmitting antenna must maintain the tower in the manner prescribed by the Commission's rules and the terms of the expired license.²
