Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed November 4, 2013, on behalf of Grundy County Broadcasters, Inc. ("GCB"). GCB requests a third extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on March 28, 2012, to continue operating Station WCSJ-FM with reduced power.<sup>1</sup> GCB states that improvements to the station's transmitting antenna equipment are essentially completed and final testing is under way. A modification of license application on FCC Form 302-FM is expected shortly.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made substantial progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.



<sup>1</sup> WCSJ-FM is licensed for operation on Channel 276A (103.1 MHz) with effective radiated power of 6 kilowatts (Max-DA, H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 100 meters.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WCSJ-FM may continue to operate with reduced power. GCB must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. GCB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **February 6, 2014**.
