
Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration the above-captioned application for a new low power FM (LPFM) station.

An engineering study has revealed that the proposed transmitter site specified in the application fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 73.807 in relation to first-adjacent channel license, BLED-20081014AFI, KMIH(FM), Mercer Island, WA. The required separation is 13 kilometers, whereas the separation proposed is 10 kilometers. Also, the application fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 73.807 in relation to co-channel translator license, BLFT-20030320ACJ, Issaquah, WA. The minimum required separation is 39 kilometers, whereas the separation proposed is 27.5 kilometers. Lastly, the application fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 73.807 in relation to second-adjacent channel license, BLED-20020402AAC, Seattle, WA. The minimum required separation is 73 kilometers, whereas the separation proposed is 18 kilometers. The application fails to address this defect.

Accordingly, in light of the above, application BNPL-20131114AJR is unacceptable for filing and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.283 and 73.870(c).¹
