Dear Applicant:

We are currently processing your above-referenced applications.

Our records indicate that there are two pending minor change applications. You can not have two pending construction permits at the same time, accordingly the latest filed application BPTTL-20050331BNC supersedes the modification application BMPTT-20040525AJW; therefore, BMPTTL-20040525AJW IS HEREBY DISMISSED.

Our preliminary engineering review of BPTTL-20050331BNC reveals that the proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. K49IB, Estes Park, CO. – BMPTTL-20040521AHW.

In addition to the above interference issue, our analysis revealed the following issue:

2. The proposed coordinates are a distance of 57.753 kilometers (35.886 miles) from the current license coordinates. Justification for the distance is required.

You are hereby given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve the specified interference issue and the excessive distance between coordinates issue within (30) days from the date of this letter. If not so amended resolving the above mentioned issues, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.
