Dear Counsel:

This letter is in reference to the above-captioned license application and your request for program test authority ("PTA") for station WMFS(AM).

Authority is granted WMFS(AM) to conduct program tests in accordance with its construction permit (BP-20101022AAH) and Section 73.1620 of the Commission's rules on 680 kHz with a daytime nominal power of 8 kilowatts and a nighttime nominal power of 5 kilowatts. Program tests are authorized with a daytime antenna input power of 8 kilowatts (current of 12.65 amperes), a nighttime input power of 5.4 kilowatts (common point current of 10.39 amperes), and with the antenna monitor parameters shown on Form 302-AM.

This authority expires on **March 11, 2014**.

A preliminary engineering study of the license application revealed the following deficiency:

1. Applicant did not include measurements to establish that sampling devices agree within the manufacturer's rated accuracy in accordance with Section 73.151(2)(i).

Further action on the subject application will be withheld until the applicant submits an amendment. Failure to respond within 60 days from the date of this letter may result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the rules.
