## Dear Licensees:

This is with respect to the March 16, 2012 *Order to Show Cause* released by the Video Division, in which the licenses of the above-captioned stations, all of which are controlled by Una Vez Maz, LP, were ordered to show cause why their respective authorizations should not be modified from Class A to low power television status.<sup>2</sup>

Section 316(a) of the Communications Act, as amended, permits the Commission to modify an authorization if such action is in the public interest.<sup>3</sup> Further, pursuant to Section 316(a), we are required to notify the affected station of the proposed action, as well as the public interest reasons for the action, and to afford the licensee at least 30 days to respond. Una Vez Mas has voluntarily downgraded two of the above-captioned stations to low-power status. Upon a review of the totality of the circumstances, we determine that modification of the remaining three low power stations at issue here would not serve the public interest.

ACCORDINGLY, the *Order to Show Cause* proceeding **IS TERMINATED**.
