## Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed December 18, 2013, on behalf of Multicultural Radio Broadcasting License, LLC ("MRB"). MRB requests special temporary authority ("STA") to operate station KIQI(AM) with a temporary nondirectional antenna at reduced power. In support of the request, MRB states that the KIQI(AM) directional antenna system has failed. After considerable effort, service was restored however technical issues are prohibiting the station from operating within its licensed parameters. Therefore, MRB requests an STA to operate KIQI(AM) at reduced power in a non-directional mode.

Section 73.1680 of the Commission's rules provides for operation with emergency antenna facilities, provided that an informal request for continued use of an emergency antenna is filed with the Commission within 24 hours. In particular, Section 73.1680(b)(1) provides that AM stations using an emergency nondirectional antenna in lieu of authorized directional facilities shall operate with power reduced to 25 percent or less of the nominal licensed power, or a higher power, not exceeding licensed power, while insuring that the radiated field strength does not exceed that authorized in any given azimuth.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KIQI(AM) may operate during daytime and nighttime hours with an emergency nondirectional antenna and reduced power not to exceed 2.5 kilowatts daytime and 0.125 kilowatt nighttime. Tower #1 of the KIQI(AM) licensed array will be employed for the non-directional operation. The antenna structure registration number (ASRN) for the tower is 1056743. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. MRB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> KIQI(AM) is licensed for operation on 1010 kHz with 10 kilowatts daytime and 0.5 kilowatt nighttime, employing different directional antenna patterns daytime and nighttime (DA-2-U).

This authority expires on June 17, 2014.

STA Advisory: Section 309(f) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, authorizes the Commission to grant STA in cases of "extraordinary circumstances requiring temporary authorizations in the public interest and when delay in the institution of the temporary operations would seriously prejudice the public interest." However, Section 309(f) is not a means by which a licensee/permittee may circumvent established processing procedures which require the filing of an application, nor is it a means by which a broadcaster may enhance his facility or make operation more convenient for the broadcaster. Stations operating with less than licensed facilities under temporary authorities can be viewed as receiving the benefit of a larger protection area than that in which they are currently providing service.

Accordingly, Special Temporary Authorities by nature are to be temporary and are not intended for extended use. Licensees of stations operating under temporary authorities are reminded that timely restoration of permanent facilities is the responsibility of the licensee and should be undertaken expeditiously. Any request for extension of special temporary authorities carries an increased burden with each subsequent request.

Therefore, requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.
