## Dear Applicant:

This refers to your attorney's letter dated December 31, 2013, for special temporary authority (STA) to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate that due to a UPS failure and other technical problems, WLTV has been operating with its auxiliary antenna at reduced power since December 5, 2013. You mentioned that the station experienced more damage from roof leakage due to the rain storms to one of the main transmitter's cabinet on December 26 and requests operating at 50% of its authorized power (500 kW ERP instead of 1000 kW ERP). You state that reduced power operations will continue to be necessary while the applicant is trying to repair the failed system and restore full power operation.

In light of the above, special temporary authority pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules until July 6, 2014 IS GRANTED.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
