Dear Mr. Campbell:

This is in reference to the request filed on December 17, 2013. YBC requests further extension of the STA originally granted on March 17, 2006, to operate Station KVNA with emergency antenna facilities pursuant to Section 73.1680 due to loss of the licensed site.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, YBC states that it plans to file an FCC Form 301 application to modify the licensed facility by duplexing with station KAFF(AM), Flagstaff, Arizona.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our records indicate that YBC has been operating via STA since 2006. As a result, to avoid a possible cancellation of this STA, YBC must either submit an FCC Form 301 application

to duplex with station KAFF(AM) by the expiration date shown below, or submit new updated information concerning all steps taken towards filing an FCC Form 301 application for a different site if YBC has determined that it will be unable to finalize a lease agreement for the KAFF(AM) site.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KVNA may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates: 35° 13' 43" N, 111° 34' 05" W (NAD 1927)

Frequency: 600kHz

Hours of operation: Unlimited


Operating power: Not to exceed 1 kW daytime, 0.048 kW nighttime

Antenna: Long wire

It will be necessary to reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. YBC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.<sup>2</sup> YBC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commissions exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **July 10, 2014**.
