Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. McCormick:

This letter concerns the request you filed on October 18, 2013, on behalf of Estuardo Valdemar Rodriguez ("EVR"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit AM Radio Station WLLN to remain silent.

EVR's request states that Station WLLN(AM) went silent on October 17, 2013, for financial reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹

EVR's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WLLN(AM) to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WLLN(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., October 18, 2014. See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
