> > Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Dow:

This letter concerns the request you filed on October 24, 2013, on behalf of Munson Radio, Inc. ("MRI"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit AM Radio Station KEIN to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that MRI stated that Station KEIN(AM) went silent on April 25, 2013, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on July 31, 2013, and expires on January 27, 2014. MRI requests extension of its STA because its technical problems continue. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

MRI's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KEIN(AM) to remain silent until April 25, 2014. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KEIN(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., April 26, 2014.¹ See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
