Dear Mr. Lipp:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 2, 2014. RLH requests an extension of the STA originally granted on March 7, 2013, to operate station KKOH(AM) with parameters at variance from license values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within license limits.¹ In support of the request, RLH states that it is preparing to file an FCC Form 302 license application shortly with new MOM proof measurements so that a new license can be granted and STA operation discontinued.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KKOH(AM) may

operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. RLH must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² RLH must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on April 23, 2014.
