On behalf of Holy Family Communications, this is to respond to your inquiry letter of December 20, 2011.

Please be advised that WQOM (AM) resumed operation of WQOM pursuant to Section 73.1615(b)(6) of the Commission's rules, operating from its nighttime site, as of December 1, 2010. On December 17, 2010, undersigned Counsel for Holy Family Communications sent a letter to the FCC, by regular USPS mail, to the Attn. of the Audio Division to advise them that this temporary operation would continue pending construction and testing pursuant to its construction permit BMP- 20100811ABC. A copy of that letter is attached. WQOM has continued to so operate to this date.

A review of undersigned Counsel's records showed no date-stamped return copy of the letter from the Commission; a return copy would have been included in the mailing as a matter of routine. Accordingly, we speculate that the Dec. 17 advisory letter may have gone awry.

Undersigned Counsel assumed that this notification would have sufficed as a notice of resumption of operations for WQOM, and no separate "Resumption of Operations" application was filed in CDBS. If this procedure was not correct, undersigned Counsel sincerely application the error.
