Dear Applicant:

This refers to your attorney's letter dated February 19, 2014, for special temporary authority (STA) to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). As noted on your previous STA (20140218AGL), KOIN Experienced a burn out of its main antenna system, and is now at 50% of its authorized power. You mentioned that in order to repair the antenna, the station power must be shut off completely for several hours at a time, and you request authority to operate a low-power 0.955 kW antenna on the same property (i.e., on the same transmitter building and not the tower) during the short periods that the KOIN antenna must be completely powered off for repair. You state that reduced power operations will continue to be necessary while the applicant is trying to repair the failed system and restore full power operation.

In light of the above, special temporary authority pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules until August 25, 2014 IS GRANTED.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
