## Dear Applicant:

This refers to your attorney's letter dated March 12, 2014, for special temporary authority (STA) to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate that although the antenna system and the transmission line are in place, a transmitter with sufficient power output capability to reach the authorized ERP of 63 kW is not on hand. Accordingly, the station's capacity is limited to 500 watts. You state that reduced power operations will continue to be necessary while the applicant is trying to make a transmitter with sufficient power output available and restore full power operation.

In light of the above, special temporary authority pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules until September 18, 2014 IS GRANTED.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
