Dear Mr. Lipp:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 18, 2014. RLHC requests an extension of the STA granted on August 22, 2013, to operate station KKAT(AM) with reduced power during daytime hours due to severe damage to the station's daytime transmitter. In support of the request, RLHC states that they continue to determine whether the transmitter can be repaired or must be replaced.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

We noted in the past six month STA period that RLHC did not submit a list of what transmitter repairs were made (or those that remain) to verify if substantial progress had been

made. As a result, in order to avoid a possible cancellation of this STA, we recommend that RLHC purchase and install a new transmitter before the expiration data shown below if unable to repair the damaged transmitter within the next 30 - 60 days.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KKAT(AM) may continue to operate with reduced power. RLHC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. RLHC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on August 24, 2014.
