Dear Mr. Jacobs:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 19, 2014. RVCM requests a sixth extension of the STA originally granted on November 2, 2009, to operate Station WVZN with temporary facilities (due to loss of the licensed site).<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, RVCM states that it plans to file an FCC Form 301 application within the next two weeks and then sell the station (after the new site facility has been constructed).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that WVZN has been operating on and off via technical STA due to loss of the licensed site in 2007, but did not file an acceptable FCC Form 301 application or submit any new information to verify that substantial progress had been made in the past six months. As a result, we recommend that RVCM retain a private consulting engineer now to

prepare and file an FCC Form 301 application within the next 30-60 days. Failure to file the application (or to list what steps have been taken towards resumption of licensed operations) before the expiration date shown below may lead to a cancellation of this STA.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WVZN may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates	40° 01' 28" N, 76° 28' 31" W (NAD 1927)
Frequency	1580 KHz
Hours of operation	Unlimited
Operating power	Not to exceed 0.5 kW daytime, 0.005 kW nighttime
Antenna type	long wire
Overall height	9.1 meters (30')

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. RVCN must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.<sup>2</sup> RVCN must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **August 26, 2014**.
