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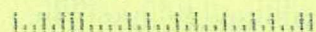


Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change application for W275BD, Greenfield, IN.

An engineering study of the application reveals that it is in violation of 47 C.F.R. § 74.1204(a) with respect to WRZX(FM) (BMLH-20061208ACR), Indianapolis, IN, and WMDH-FM (BLH-19790912AC), New Castle, IN. The proposed interfering contour (94 dBu) is fully encompassed by the protected contours (54 dBu) of WRZX and WMDH-FM respectively. The applicant recognizes this violation and requests that the existing exhibit complying with 74.1204(d), at the licensed site, to be used at the proposed site. However, since the proposed site is at a different location, the applicant must submit a new exhibit that complies with Section 74.1204(d).

In light of the above, the application BPFT-20120926AGY is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a) and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
