Letter Request pursuant to 73.1560(d)

Chester County Radio, Incorporated, Licensee of WCHE(AM), 1520 KHz, West Chester, PA (Fac. ID 71279) files this Letter Notification pursuant to 73.1560(d), Request for 30 day authority to operate with technical parameters at variance with the terms and conditions of current License, File Number BL-20090625ACZ.

WCHE(AM) recently hired a new station engineer after the previous engineer retired. On a routine inspection by the undersigned, at the request of my client, I determined several issues with regards to the data reliability with respect to the copper telephone line based Remote Control system utilized by WCHE(AM) for Remote Control of its transmitter from its studios. It is unlikely that the root cause(s) of the problems will be corrected within 10 days as required by 73.1560(d), we therefore request authority for 30 days to completely evaluate the system after repairs are accomplished.

During this period, we will continue to comply with Monitoring Point limits as spelled out in BL-20090625ACZ which may require operation with operating power at or below the normal 90% of Licensed. We also note that the indicated directional parameters from the station Antenna Monitor are within the standard limits as outlined in BL-20090625ACZ.
