PETITION FOR LEAVE TO FILE FURTHER SUPPLEMENT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Toccoa Falls College ("the College"), licensee of WTXR(FM), Toccoa Falls, Georgia, pursuant to Section 1.106(f)¹ of the Commission's Rules, by its counsel, respectfully files this Petition for Leave to file its "Further Supplement to Petition for Reconsideration," filed simultaneously herewith. The College's Petition for Reconsideration was filed August 27, 2012, directed to the Media Bureau's ("MB") *Forfeiture Order*, 27 FCC Rcd 8365 (2012), that imposed a \$10,000 forfeiture on the College for alleged violation of Section 73.3527 of the Rules by "failing to retain all required documentation in the WTXR(FM), public inspection file...." On November 1, 2012, pursuant to a request from the Commission's staff, the College filed a Supplement

to Petition for Reconsideration accompanied by a Petition for Leave to File Supplement to Petition for Reconsideration.

The College is filing its Further Supplement at the invitation of the Media Bureau staff to provide additional information for its consideration in connection with this case. As the Further Supplement is being filed pursuant to a request from the Commission's staff, which was communicated to undersigned counsel on November 5, 2012, the College is, once more, moving with alacrity to provide the information. Therefore, good cause exists for accepting and considering the College's Further Supplement.

Wherefore, the College respectfully requests the Media Bureau to accept and consider its Further Supplement to Petition for Reconsideration.
