In the final amendment I filed to KVTE-LP last week, I neglected to update Exhibit 11. It should read:

THE SUBJECT ANTENNA STRUCTURE IS NOT SUBJECT TO FAA NOTIFICATION PROCEDURES PURSUANT TO SECTION 17.14 OF THE FCC RULES. THE ANTENNA IS BEING MOUNTED ON AN POLE ON TOP OF AN EXISTING BUILDING AND THE TOP OF THE ANTENNA IS LESS THAN 6 METERS IN HEIGHT ABOVE THE BUILDING AND THE ANTENNA WOULD NOT INCREASE THE HEIGHT OF ANOTHER ANTENNA STRUCTURE. SPECIFICALLY, THE BUILDING IS 8 meters (28 FEET) TALL. THE LICENSEE WILL USING A POLE ON TOP OF THE ROOF OF THE TOWER THAT ONLY IS 3.6

METERS TALL. THEREFORE, NO FAA APPROVAL WILL BE NECESSARY.
